

The Cannon County Election Commission met on August 12, 2013. All members were present. No media and 2 visitors were present. AOE Mankin was present.

1. Meeting was called to order by Chm Davenport.
2. Prayer was led by M Grosch.
3. Pledge was stated by all members.
4. A motion was made by Gannon to accept the minutes of the July meeting. Grosch seconded. All in favor.
5. 23 new voter registrations were reviewed by Grosch and Gannon. No irregularities were found. Most of these had been received by mail from DHS or driver's license stated Mankin.
6. Budget update- Mankin stated no more budget changes had been recommended by budget committee and full commission was to vote on budget on Aug 13.
7. Report from Mankin. Middle TN TACEO will be at Smith County on Wed Sept 25 at 9:00 a.m. She needed to know who would attend. Patrick and Studd were interested in attending. Mankin gave a report on voting machine upgrades. \$28,314 will be available from the state for these upgrades which will include making the screens more visible and reducing glare. Machines have not been upgraded since 2005. Gannon made a motion to approve grant and Grosch seconded. All voted to approve. Jackie Gannon was recognized by the state with a certificate for 30 years of service.

9. Website update- Mankin will meet with Chris Smith with Ink Blot graphics in her office on the 16, this Friday.
10. Discussion. Studd asked about if illegals were attempting to register and if updates from the Circuit Court Clerk were being received. Mankin stated she was receiving updates. Mankin stated that Mike Gannon was waiting on Architect and Fire Marshall to get back to him about adding another entrance. She stated Mike Gannon had said the hall and office tile would be replaced and a dumpster would be place in the parking lot. Mankin had no other fire marshall update.
