



The Cannon County Election Commission met on February 9, 2015 at the election office.

1. Chairman Davenport called the meeting to order. All were present except for Gannon who was a few minutes late.
2. Grosch led the prayer.
3. All recited the pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.
4. The Jan 2015 minutes were read and approved after Grosch made the motion and Studd seconded. All in favor and Gannon arrived.
5. New voter registrations were reviewed by Grosch and Patrick. There were 19 of these and no irregularities were found.
6. Mankin stated she would be having a high school voter registration the following day. She mentioned the budget for 2015-2016. 131 letters had been sent out for voter maintenance and 34 had been returned as undeliverable. Having been discussed earlier, Matt Studd made a motion that we recognize 56 hours of comp time for Rachel Young and send to the county executive's office and let them make a determination as to pay or deny and advise in writing. Gannon seconded. All voted yes except Patrick who abstained. It was discussed this would not be overtime but just extra hours worked before and after the election. This could be paid from election workers because we have \$5000 left in this. Extra hours for an election are above the deputy's salary and should be paid.
7. Studd made a motion pertaining to the 100 ft boundary that there would no video Or audio recording. Grosch seconded. Motion passed after all in favor.
8. Studd made motion to adjourn with Grosch seconding. Meeting adjourned.
