

The Cannon County Election Commission met on December 8, 2014 at the election office. All members were present along with AOE Mankin.

1. Davonport called the meeting to order.
2. Grosch said the prayer.
3. All recited the pledge.
4. The November minutes were approved after Studd made the motion and Patrick seconded. All in favor.
5. 11 new voter registrations were viewed by Grosch and Gannon with no discrepancies being found.
6. Mankin reported the state election office audited the maintenance review. Wayne Pruitt looked at the maintenance records including files purged and new voter registrations being notified 5 days prior to the election that they have been rejected. Studd made the motion to approve the list maintenance review with Grosch seconding. All were in favor.
7. The 2015 election commission meeting schedule was reviewed and approved. Studd made the motion and Gannon seconded. The venue for the meeting will be posted on facebook and the website. It will be posted in the Courier and WBRY one time. Changing the venue back to the election office was approved after Studd made the motion and Gannon seconded. All in favor.
8. In regard to cameras and videos within the 100 ft boundary was discussed. Mankin spoke with Beth at the state office and was told to check with the District Attorney. It was decided to check with Mark Goins at the state office. Patrick made a motion to table until Goins was asked and Davonport could check with the District Attorney. Gannon seconded. All in favor of this.
