

The Cannon County Election Commission met on January 12, 2015 at the election office. All members except Jackie Gannon were present. AOE Mankin was in attendance.

1. Chairman Davenport called the meeting to order.
2. Grosch led the prayer.
3. All recited the pledge of allegiance.
4. Grosch made a motion to approve the December 2014 minutes. Studd seconded. All in favor.
5. Voter registrations were reviewed by Grosch and Patrick. No irregularities were found in the 29 applications.
6. Mankin gave a report indicating the legislative breakfast would be held on February 25. The spring TACEO meeting was discussed. 357 persons have been purged because they have not voted in 2 November elections. In 2011 they were notified that they could be purged if they did not vote in next elections. Patrick requested a list of the purged voters and Mankin stated she would email one. Rachel Young has left to accept another job. Mankin asked about comp time being paid to Rachel. Patrick stated she would check with the county executive's office. Mankin stated Sandy Alexander would start work on the 19<sup>th</sup>.
7. Davenport asked the district attorney, Jennings Jones, about photography within the election boundaries. Unless they were hindering someone from voting, this prohibition could be a problem. It was discussed there would be no picture taking within the 100 ft boundary; however, if someone wanted to make a picture of themselves they could. If pictures were taken of others, permission would need to be obtained from the persons in the picture.
8. Grosch made a motion to adjourn with Studd seconding. All in favor. Meeting Adjourned.
