



The Cannon County Election Commission met on Sept 9, 2013 for their regular monthly meeting. All members except Jackie Gannon were present. There was no media in attendance. AOE Mankin and Deputy Young were present along with 2 visitors.

1. Meeting called to order by Chm Davenport.
2. Mike Grosch led the prayer
3. All recited the pledge.
4. Chm Davenport asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the Aug 2013 meeting. Grosch made the motion and Studd seconded. All in favor.
5. New voter registrations. Patrick and Grosch reviewed the registration. There were 13 and of the 13 2 were getting rights restored. All were in order.
6. Mankin gave the final budget update. Young had received a 3% increase and \$300 had been taken from the election commission pay which had been previously discussed.
7. Mankin reported that a TACEO meeting would be held at the Smith Co. Ag Center and handed out directions to the Ag Center. This meeting is scheduled for Sept 25. Mankin informed the commission September is Voter Registration month. Her office will be setting up at the courthouse and at the high school. Mr. Curtis at the high school will try to get election workers. Mankin stated we now have a facebook page.
8. Website update - This is not yet working but Mankin is working with him. Cannoncountyelections.com is the address.
9. It was discussed the ambulance service may be moving in the future and maybe Save could be moved to cut down on traffic. This is a possibility and Mankin Has spoken with Mike Gannon about this. Mankin stated Gannon had been receptive to making changes with the building. Patrick asked Mankin when the parties had to advise her office if they were calling a primary and Mankin replied Nov. 22.
10. The meeting was adjourned with Patrick making the motion and Studd seconded.
