The Cannon County Election Commission met for their regular monthly meeting on January 13, 2014. All members were present along with AOE Mankin. Visitors were present.


1. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Davenport. Item 8 A picture was made for the election web page.

3. All present recited the pledge.
4. The minutes of the December meeting were approved after a motion was made by Gannon and seconded by Grosch. All in favor.
5. 19 new voter registrations were reviewed and approved by Gannon and Grosch.
6. Mankin reported the website cannoncoelections.com and the facebook page were operational. Studd asked if it was known how many hits the site had and if there was a counter. 
Patrick commented it sounded like a personal problem. Studd wanted to find out More and reminded everyone to act in a professional manner.
