

The Cannon County Election Commission met on Monday July 8, 2013. All members were present after Patrick arrived late. AOE Mankin was present along with 7 visitors.

1. The meeting was called to order by Chm. Davenport.
2. Grosch led the opening prayer.
3. All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. The June 2013 minutes were read and approved. Grosch made the motion to Approve with Studd seconding. All in favor.
5. New voter registrations were reviewed by Gannon and Grosch.
6. Budget Update- 3% raise was included for Young's increase. \$300 had been reduced from election commission. \$22000 in contracted services was discussed
7. Report from AOE. All future summer meetings will be held in Nashville. \$54.95 bags can be used to replace heavy metal boxes. E poll books cost \$5000 With a \$250 annual cost. It would be necessary to buy laptops. Gannon made a motion to table e poll book discussion with Studd seconding. Gannon made a motion to buy the bags and rolling cart. Studd seconded. This will cost approximately \$1000 for both. All in favor.
8. Number skipped on agenda.
9. Website Discussion was had. The cost was \$2039 with no extra charge for videos. This would be with Chris at Inkblot graphics. Studd made the motion to use this site like Wilson County. Grosch seconded. All in favor.
10. TACFO update included in 7. TACFO officers were discussed. Amber Moore Was elected President and Summer Leverette was elected Secretary. Dennis Stanley was elected Middle Tenn. VP.
11. Jackie Gannon was recognized for his 30 years of service by the state election commission. A certificate was presented to Gannon and was signed by TACFO.
