



The Cannon County Election Commission met on June 10, 2013 with all members and AOE present. 6 visitors were present. Grosch, Davenport, Gannon, Studd, and Patrick. Mankin AOE.

1. Meeting called to order by Chairman Davenport.
2. Prayer was led by Matt Studd.
3. Pledge was stated by all.
4. The May minutes were discussed. Studd asked about the tech for the elections pay. Mankin stated \$50 per hr. Motion made by Gannon with Grosch seconding. All in favor.
5. New voter registrations were reviewed by Gannon and Grosch. All 24 presented Were approved.
6. Budget amendments were presented Mankin stated need to move funds from legal notices to contracted services 334. Gannon made the motion with Studd seconding. All in favor.
7. 2014 Budget Update Mankin has not heard anything. Grosch had been to the meeting and stated The election commission line had been cut fro \$5300 to \$5000.
8. Report from AOE. State grants will be available to upgrade voting machine Make more visible. Reverse printing on screen. Total cost unknown. Will be 100% grant to cover cost.
9. Website update. Eric has utube up. Minutes and agenda are on website. Studd thinks Wilson County site is better as does Mankin. This type of Website will cost \$2039 to setup. Mankin could make needed changes. Studd Made a motion to table until July and decide then Gannon seconded. All in Favor. Mankin will check on cost to include video each month.
10. TACEO election was discussed indicating the administrators from Wilson and Dekalb will be running for office. Mankin stated it was on the ballot for the annual meeting to be in Nashville each year. Voter ID was discussed with the Knowledge the county has a machine available to make these id's . Homeland Security has machine. Upcoming TACEO meeting was discussed with Grosch Davenport, Studd and Mankin planning to attend.
