


**ELECTION COMMISSION
MEETING
SCHEDULED FOR MONDAY JUNE 9,
2014
5:30 P.M.**

**HELD AT THE CANNON COUNTY
COURTHOUSE
WOODBURY, TENN.**

On June 9, 2014 the Cannon County Election Commission met in the courtroom for the regular meeting. All members were present along with AOE Mankin.

1. Chairman Davenport called the meeting to order.
2. Grosch led the prayer.
3. All recited the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. The May 19 minutes were viewed and Grosch made a motion to accept with Gannon seconding. All in favor
The May 29 minutes were viewed and Gannon made the motion to accept with Grosch seconding. All in favor.
5. 141 new voter registrations were checked by both Grosch and Gannon. Mankin stated this brings the registered voter count to over 8600.
6. Mankin reported the poll worker training would take place on July 10 with Sue's Deli providing the meal. A plaque will be presented to long time workers Mamie Bell and Christine Rich who feel unable to work anymore. The Courier will be called to make pictures Over 60 population have received letters regarding absentee voting. State is working on an App for the I phone that would assist us on election night in corresponding with Keith Recdy with WBRY who will be at the courthouse. The courtroom has been reserved if the weather is not suitable. Mankin stated school organizations will be allowed to sell one item election night. She is coordinating this.
TACEO has suggested weather radios for each location. After discussion, it was decided to have one at the election office and the office could notify the locations if problems.
Different colored pens will be used for the workers and the voters. Green for the workers and blue for the voters to simplify matters.
Sue Patrick was presented a certificate for 15 years of service with Studd and Mankin receiving one for 5 each.
There is a write in candidate for the commission Dist 3 - Delinda Parton. The Commissioners (one from each party) locked and sealed the ballot bags and boxes.
7. Gannon asked to move the meeting back to the election office and Davenport Stated we would put on agenda for next meeting.
8. Meeting adjourned.
