The Cannon County Election Commission met on May 13, 2013. All members were present except Sue Patrick. AOE Mankin and Deputy Young were in attendance. 5 guests were present.

- Items 1 and 2 Corey Davenport called the meeting to order and led the prayer .
 - Item 3 All members recited the pledge to the flag
 - Item 4 The April 2013 minutes were approved with Studd making the motion to approve and Grosch seconding. All members voted yes.
 - Item 5 136 voters had been purged and 56 voters filed new registrations.
Several from the high school have agreed to work in upcoming elections.
 - Item 8 Studd made a motion to table the web site maintenance agreement. Seconded by Grosch. All in favor.
- Patrick arrived at meeting.

- Item 6 Budget review. Discussions regarding TCRS retirement. Patrick will check on withdrawals, vesting, etc. Increase in medical insurance premiums discussed. A 5% increase was included in Deputy Young's salary which amounts to \$1004 While increasing the salary to \$21089. Gannon made the motion to increase the Salary in the budget and Studd seconded. All in favor
Mankin explained about the election workers pay and an increase was discussed. Workers are paid \$10 per hour for early voting, techs are paid \$50 per hour, the Counting board is paid \$100 each. Election day workers are paid \$100 plus \$20 for training and the officer of elections is paid \$140 with \$20 for training.


Mankin estimated the total budget to be \$160,488 which was less than the current Year of \$167,667. Microvote fees and the retirement were discussed.

Studd made a motion to approve the budget with Gannon seconding. All in Favor.

- Item 7 Mankin discussed the upcoming TACEO meeting.
Eric Fisk arrived and was asked about placing videos on website. He will check on this.
Patrick was made up to date on earlier business about 136 voters being purged.

- Item 9 No other business to come before the commission.
