The Cannon County Election Commission met on September 8, 2014 with members Davenport, Grosch and Patrick present along with AOE Mankin.

1. Meeting was called to order by Chairman Davenport.
2. Opening Prayer was led by Mike Grosch.
3. All recited pledge of Allegiance.
4. The minutes were read and approved after Grosch made the motion and Patrick seconded.
5. 73 new voter registrations were reviewed by Grosch and Patrick. All were Completed satisfactorily.
6. The report by Mankin included that the commission had to approve to place The referendum on the ballot about liquor by the drink. After discussion Mankin informed the commission this was required by law before this could be placed on the ballot. 426 Signatures had been turned in and verified on the petition that required only 392 which was 10% of the voters voting the last gubernatorial election in 2010. After more discussion, Patrick made the motion if the petition meets all requirements by law that the election commission is required to place the referendum on the ballot and Grosch seconded. The vote was 3 to 0 with all voting for.
7. AOE Mankin stated the road route would be on the November ballot. Grosch Made the motion with Patrick seconding. All in favor. She stated early voting would begin October 15. 9-12 Saturday, 2-6 Thurs, 9-1 Monday, Tues, Wed, Friday. Our next meeting will be on October 13, Columbus Day. There was discussion about the school board members running. None have qualified but Tim Powers, Frank Walkup, and John Basinger have picked up petitions. Sue Patrick made a motion to approve workers used in the previous election and to designate the same people to represent the respective parties. Grosch seconded and all in favor. Grosch made a motion to buy a faster printer to replace the slower one. Patrick seconded. All in favor.
8. Davenport had prices for generators and Patrick asked this to be tabled until all Members were present. This was agreeable.
9. Patrick asked Mankin if Keith Reedy would announce the election results. Mankin will check. Discussion about the photo id and if the legislature would pass this so the election office could make these because we don't have a driver's license place. Davenport stated he would ask Rep. Pody about this.
10. Patrick made a motion to adjourn. Grosch seconded. Meeting adjourned.
